### SNF QRP: Assessment-Based Measures Confidential Feedback Reports

In Tuesday's SNF-QRP webinar, CMS along with their contractor RTI, explained what providers can expect to see on the upcoming confidential feedback reports. These reports, titled SNF QRP QM Reports, will include both facility-level and resident-level assessment-based data, as well as, facility-level claims-based data. The IMPACT Act requires that confidential feedback reports be made available to providers prior to public reporting of the measures. The SNF QRP QM Reports are expected to be available, on-demand, in each facility's CASPER application within the next week. They will be updated monthly. Public reporting of the measures is to begin in October 2018.

#### The SNF QRP QM MDS 3.0 assessment-based measures include:

- 1.) Percent of Resident or Patients with Pressure Ulcers That Are New or Worsened (Short Stay) (NQF #0678)
- 2.) Application of Percent of Long-Term Care Hospital (LTCH) Patients with an Admission and Discharge Functional Assessment and a Care Plan that Addresses Function (NQF #2631)
- 3.) Application of Percent of Residents Experiencing One or More Falls with Major Injury (Long Stay) (NQF #0674)

CMS emphasized a difference in the QM reports compared to the SNF QRP Review and Correct Reports, in that, the QM reports show the observed and risk adjusted scores, whereas, the Review and Correct reports show only the observed scores.

Providers are encouraged to access their SNF QRP QM reports when they are made available. Facility- and resident-level QM reports are intended to help providers understand the measures and their performance for quality improvement purposes.
